NS2

Had 13 Lots for WAN, LAN, various telephony services, mobile data services, conferencing, and unified communications.

Maximum call off length of 5 years with an optional extension of up to 2 years. It allowed up to 10 years for particular services!

Suppliers were asked to meet specific financial, technical and competency criteria to get listed.



NS3

Has 4 Lots covering:

- WAN Inter-site connectivity
- LAN intra-site connectivity
- Emerging Technologies
- Unified Communciations

Mobile Voice and Data has been removed to become its own framework.

Maximum call off length of 3 years with an optional extension of one year

On top of the financial, technical and competency criteria, we will likely see social value scored in applications.
